Quiet time: the time you set apart in your day to spend time with the Lord.

- Jesus went away and spent time with His father.
- Scripture is God-breathed, it's for our growth.
- The enemy comes against us to not have a quiet time because that strips us of the life source we have in Christ.
- The only way we know the Truth is if we are reading God's Word and knowing the voice of the Father.
- #1: Are you busy or are you distracted?
- There are times when we're in a busy season, but there are also times when we're distracted with social media, priorities, etc.
- #2: Are you truly busy because of your season or because you won't say no (overloaded yourself)?
- Sometimes we pour out for other people but we don't pour into ourselves because we're exhausted.
- Let go of the perfect or "instagrammable" quiet time.
- Seek the Lord in every little crack in your day.
- Walk with Him in little chunks of time all throughout the day.
- Look at your day and see where it fits.
- Book of Psalms on your kitchen counter read a Psalm every day.
- Write scripture that you're memorizing over the sink, memorize while you're washing dishes.
- Make sure that you're making a point to have Bibles, verses, etc. all around you.
- Have things all around you so you can dive into God's Word where the moment hits you.
